

What Skills Do Many Kindergarteners Have?

The following skills are ones that are usually learned in pre-school or pre-kindergarten settings:

- Knows and can state telephone number and address
- Recognizes colors and shapes
- Uses scissors for cutting
- Rote counts from 1-10
- Counts objects to 10
- Takes turns easily
- Speaks clearly
- Prints first name
- Sits and listens to a story
- Recognizes 15/26 upper case letters or more of the alphabet
- Recognizes 15/26 lower case letters or more of the alphabet
- Separates easily from parent
- Colors pictures completely and stays in the lines.
- Follows 2 to 3 step directions
